CHIEF JUDGE JUDITH S. KAYE

The Editors of the *New York University Law Review* are pleased to present these Tributes to the Honorable Judith S. Kaye, in recognition of her twenty-five years of dedicated service to the State of New York.

Appointed in 1983, Chief Judge Kaye was the first woman to serve on the New York Court of Appeals, the State's highest court, and in 1993 she became the first woman to serve as its Chief Judge. As the head of the New York court system, she gained national renown for her wise jurisprudence and her innovative administrative reforms. She retired last year as the longest serving Chief Judge in New York history.
